HBT is continuing to build a **Sustainability Fund**, a long-term reserve for major infrastructure and operational needs. The Sustainability Fund will help HBT to be stable and resilient when unexpected major expenses arise and to ensure that we invest appropriately in maintaining our building. All members are asked to contribute to the Sustainability Fund. Suggested levels are included in the charts below.

The amount you pay for dues, the sustainability fund and tuition will be treated as confidential.
